



AMC and Medical Board of Australia 2019 Preparedness for Internship Survey FAQs

The Preparedness for Internship Survey was first run in 2017. The survey was designed to find out how well interns felt their medical school course had prepared them for internship and, using the AMC's and the Medical Board's standards setting and accreditation roles, to improve how medical schools prepare graduates for internship. Feedback on the survey has been positive. Medical schools have reported making changes in response to feedback from their graduates and, in some areas medical schools and those responsible for internship have come together to discuss how to better support the transition from medical school to internship.

What is the Preparedness for Internship Survey?

It is online, voluntary and anonymous
