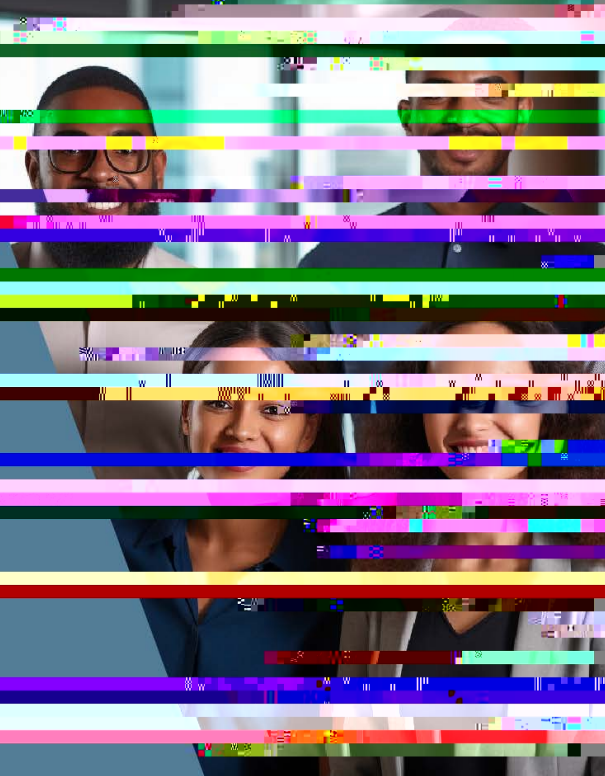

International Medical Graduates Experiences Survey



What is the International Medical Graduate Experiences Survey?

- project being carried out by the Australian Medical Council designed to understand better the journeys that international medical graduates take to practise medicine in Australia, and the contribution that they make once they are in the workforce.
- The broader project includes focus groups and interviews with international medical graduates, supervisors, health services, education providers and other health industry stakeholders who work with international medical graduates.
- The information from the survey, interviews and focus groups will provide a deeper understanding of the needs, expectations and challenges faced by international medical graduates

How long will the survey take?

- The survey will take 10-15 minutes. You can return to the survey at a later time. The results of the survey will be published on the AMC website and distributed to a broad range of stakeholders.
- The results may also be published in reports, academic journal articles and presented at conferences.
- The survey is anonymous and secure.
- No one will be able to identify you in the survey data or published results.
